## SOSDAS (SIGN-ON, STAND-DOWN, ABANDON SAFE)

SOSDAS is the core of the Dieppe Dash Sea-Safety policy for all participating boats. It is imperative the person-in-charge and all crew are fully aware of, and adhere to, this Sea Safety policy:

### 1 SEA SAFETY INFORMATION

Details of each boat (given as part of entry) will be passed to HM Coastguard; any changes of details since entry must be notified before the Sea Safety Information Cut-Off date –We will notify search and rescue services of any boat thought to be missing at sea.

- 1.1 SOSDAS time format is BST; I.E. UTC (GMT) +1hr - Please use BST format for all SOSDAS notifications; please follow any times used in your message with the designatory letters 'BST'.
- 1.2 No later than time of 'Sea Safety Cut-Off', the organisers must hold confirmed details for each participating boat:
  - (i) Nominated contact mobile telephone number for the boat (SOSDAS Registered Boat Contact Number);
  - (ii) Name and contact telephone number of the nominated shoreside contact (it is recommended your shoreside contact holds name, address and next-of-kin details for each person on-board – The organisers will not require these details);
  - (iii) Number of persons on-board over 18 years of age (Adults);
  - (iv) Number of persons on-board under 18 years of age (Minors);
  - (v) Boat type, hull colour, sail number (if any), MMSI number;
  - (vi) Will make return passage from Dieppe to Home Port on Sunday, 5th May 2019 (Yes or No).
- 1.3 Sea Safety information may be sent by email to [admin@dieppedash.com](mailto:admin@dieppedash.com) or by sending a completed Sea Safety Registration Form to BMYC Office. [admin@dieppedash.com](mailto:admin@dieppedash.com) - <http://www.dieppedash.com/documents/>
- 1.4 The Organisers will monitor Safety at Sea on the Outbound Passage for all participating boats; it is imperative all boats give notification, using the SOSDAS procedure, **on putting to sea and arriving at Port of Intended Destination/arriving at an Alternative Port of Safety.**
- 1.5 Boats making return passage on Sunday, 5th May 2019 are invited to declare departing Dieppe and arrival at safe haven via SOSDAS regardless of their port of destination.
- 1.6 The SOSDAS procedure will not be operational after Sunday, 5th May 2019; instead, at the discretion of the Person-in-Charge, HM Coastguard should be informed of arrival at port of safety.
- 1.7 Please remember to Stand-Down your Shoreside Contact Person ASAP following safe arrival at the home port, this may save unnecessary concern by your Shoreside Contact person and telephone calls to HM Coastguard.

- 2.1 SOSDAS Number (above) **shall not** be used for any communication matter whatsoever, other than matters relating to safety of boats at sea.

## 3 SOSDAS REGISTRATION

- 3.1 Register the boat mobile phone on the day of 'Sea Safety Cut-Off' between 09:00hrs and 22:00hrs

- a) Send text message to the SOSDAS number (above) in the format:
- (i) Boat Name [Space] REGISTER SOSDAS;
  - (ii) e.g. My Boat REGISTER SOSDAS.
- b) Receive confirmation text in the format (May not respond immediately):
- (i) RECEIVED Boat Name [Space] REGISTER SOSDAS;
  - (ii) e.g. RECEIVED My Boat REGISTER SOSDAS.

**The Boat's mobile phone registered for SOSDAS must be able to send and receive SMS messages in UK and France.**

## 4 SIGN-ON (ON PUTTING TO SEA

- 4.1 On putting to sea (NOT before) 'Sign-On':

- a) Send text message to the SOSDAS number (above) in the format:
- (i) Boat Name [Space] SIGN ON [Space] Time hh:mm BST;
  - (ii) e.g. My Boat SIGN ON 05:36 BST
- b) Receive confirmation text in the format (May not respond immediately):
- (i) RECEIVED Boat Name [Space] SIGN ON [Space] Time hh:mm BST;
  - (ii) e.g. RECEIVED My Boat SIGN ON 05:36 BST

## 5 STAND-DOWN (ON ARRIVAL AT PORT OF DESTINATION

- 5.1 On arrival at port of destination 'STAND-DOWN' by:

- a) Send text message to the SOSDAS number (above) in the format:
- (i) Boat Name [Space] STAND DOWN [Space] Time hh:mm BST;
  - (ii) e.g. My Boat STAND DOWN 21:46 BST
- b) Receive confirmation text in the format (May not respond immediately):
- (i) RECEIVED Boat Name [Space] STAND DOWN [Space] Time hh:mm BST;
  - (ii) e.g. RECEIVED My Boat STAND DOWN 21:46 BST

## 6 ABANDON-SAFE (ON ARRIVAL AT ALTERNATIVE SAFE HAVEN

- 6.1 A boat NOT completing the intended course, insodoing making for any other port than the designated destination port of Dieppe (See 'Outbound Passage') or Home Port (see 'Return Passage') - On arrival at alternative safe haven 'ABANDON SAFE' by:

- a) Send text message to the SOSDAS number (above) in the format:
- (i) Boat Name [Space] ABANDON SAFE [Space] Time hh:mm BST;
  - (ii) e.g. My Boat ABANDON SAFE 23:16 BST
- b) Receive confirmation text in the format (May not respond immediately):
- (i) RECEIVED Boat Name [Space] ABANDON SAFE [Space] Time hh:mm BST;
  - (ii) e.g. RECEIVED My Boat ABANDON SAFE 23:16 BST
